

FAGAN FLYERS MINUTES  
July 10, 2010

The Fagan Flyers meeting was held on July 10, 2010 at the Sidney Municipal Airport at 12:00 pm. Nineteen members attended.

The minutes of the June meeting had been received by all those in attendance. The minutes were accepted.

Treasurer Gene Pigford provided a detailed report of income and expenditures for the month of June. The current balance is \$5,756.42 with an additional \$100.00 in petty cash. The Treasurer's report was accepted as read.

Sarah Pressler reported that thank you acknowledgments had been sent to the businesses that assisted with our Spring Fly-In Breakfast.

A representative from Hayes Office Products met with Airport Manager Jim Roberts and Dee Fogarty to discuss the options available to replace the lounge furniture. A discussion was held concerning whether vinyl or leather would be a better choice. A motion was made by Judy Basile, and seconded by Bev Pecoraro to purchase leather furniture. The motion was passed.

A motion was made by Vera Wilson and seconded by Teri Lanciault to approve an expenditure of up to \$2,000.00 to purchase the replacement furniture for the airport lounge area. We now have a credit of \$2,100.00 as a result of the unfavorable performance of the existing lounge furniture. The motion was passed by those in attendance. Color choices will be available at our next meeting.

Judy Basile made a motion to donate the existing lounge furniture to the Boys & Girls Club. Sparks Burrows seconded the motion which was passed by the members present.

**New Business** – Sunday, October 3, 2010, will be the next Fly-In Breakfast. This event will be in conjunction with the annual car show. The cost of the Breakfast was discussed and members voted to continue to have the \$5.00 cost for adults.

A possible group trip to Old Rhinebeck Aerodrome was discussed. Dee will explore this topic further if there is sufficient interest. Members are asked to contact Dee @ 369-4071, if interested in a trip to Old Rhinebeck on a Sunday in September.

Jerry Foote presented information concerning recently imposed taxiing procedures which are required when crossing a runway. The FAA implemented the new procedures in an effort to reduce runway incursions. Active pilots should become familiar with these new rules. The meeting was adjourned at 1:50 pm. Luncheon followed.
